How is it multiplied? Through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord - a personal, accurate, and full knowledge experienced by the work & ministry of the Word and the Holy Spirit in our lives.

What is multiplied? Grace & Mercy - undeserved favor & blessing; the free gift of salvation and strength to live

- Grace is the work of God for man and encompasses everything we receive from God
- Grace stresses God’s character and man’s sinfulness
- Mercy stresses God’s strength and man’s helplessness
- Grace is God giving to us what we do not deserve
- Mercy is God “not giving” what we do deserve
- Grace means you never deserve it nor can you earn it
