A fool –one who lacks good judgment & is obstinate/stubborn dull & deficient in wisdom & disregards God's truth lacks reason and sense (described as simple to stubborn in Proverbs)

- °F *Has a spiritual problem (1:29)*
- °F *Enjoys his folly (26:11)*
- °F *No respect for truth (14:8-9)*
- °F *Is a menace to others (13:20, 18:6)*

❖ The Sacrifice of Fools (Matt 5:23-24)

- Improper (not of faith, obedience)
- Insincere (perfunctory, ritual)
- Hypocritical
- Careless

❖ The Speech of Fools

- He talks too hastily/quickly (5:2)
- He talks too much (continually, many words) (5:2,3,7) *(doesn't know how to be quiet and listen)*
- He talks too boastfully (5:4-5)
