Abounding in God's Good Work

The fruit of the Spirit – produced by the Holy Spirit at work in the children of God, not based on emotional attraction or sentimental feeling (though those may be involved) but rooted in the nature of God Himself, instilled in believers as part of His work in us, and a conscious, intentional choice to show kindness and generosity in obedience to the command of Christ.

(God loves and God is love)

Love that is growing to overflowing/abundance

Love that is growing in knowledge (truth)

Love that is growing in discernment

Abounding in God's Good Work

Approving in God's Good Work

Meaning – to examine, weigh, test, identify
“that which differs and then that which is best”
(to try and stay unentangled, not distracted, deceived, disillusioned) not led by emotion, feeling, impulsiveness, selfishness

Purpose –

Sincere – “without wax” consistent, genuine not hypocritical, honest,

Blameless – without stumbling without offense
(not tolerating sin in ones life, not causing others to sin, not regularly falling into sin as a habit nor having serious character or moral issues that remain unconfessed, unresolved, and unforsaken)
