## 3. Be \_\_\_\_\_-filled

### a. The \_\_\_\_\_

1) \_\_\_\_\_ – being born of the Spirit, receiving the Holy Spirit, baptism of the Spirit, residing of the Holy Spirit...*upon/at* salvation (*John 3:5; 7:37-39, 14:17; Rom 8:9-11, I Cor 3:16, 6:19, 12:13; II Tim 1:14*)

2) \_\_\_\_\_ – having the Holy Spirit in charge and freely working in us *after* salvation  
It is repeatable, ongoing, continuous  
(*Eph 5:18, Acts 2:4, 4:8, 6:3, 7:55, 13:52; Col 3:15-16, Gal 5:16, 18,25*)

b. The \_\_\_\_\_ – *being a follower of God, walking as children of light, walking wisely, redeeming the time, understanding what the will of the Lord is, not being unwise....not being drunk with wine but being filled*

c. The \_\_\_\_\_ – “be you being” filled

## 3. Be Spirit-filled

### a. The contrast

1) Indwelling – receiving the Holy Spirit and Him taking up residence in us at salvation  
“baptism of the Holy Spirit” aorist – once and for all (*John 7:37-39, 14:17; Rom 8:9-11, I Cor 3:16, 6:19; II Tim 1:14*)

2) Filling – having the Holy Spirit in charge and freely working in us after salvation  
repeatable, ongoing, continuous command  
(*Eph 5:18, Acts 2:4, 4:8, 6:3, 7:55, 13:52; Col 3:15-16, Gal 5:16, 18,25*)

*2<sup>nd</sup> Person Plural – all christians, every one of you*  
*Present tense – repeatable, regular, ongoing*  
*Passive voice – let the spirit fill you*  
*Imperative – a continuous command*

b. The context – being a follower of God, walking as children of light, walking circumspectly, redeeming the time, understanding what the will of the Lord is, not being unwise....don't be drunk with wine but be filled

c. The command – “be you being” filled

1) Be being controlled by the Spirit (*through yielding, submitting, placing self under His control, presenting your body a living sacrifice, yield to God*)

2) Be being influenced by the Spirit

*Empowered, directed, convinced, assured*  
The peace of God ruling, the Word of Christ dwelling
