### Guard and battle against

Coveteousness, Greed, Love of money, Self-centeredness , Laziness, Foolishness, Unwise spending habits carelessthoughtless, impulsive/rash, debt based, emotional feelings Resistance to godly counsel procrastination, worldly philosophy (you are what counts, and you are worth it, get it now, someone else will take care of it,

### Develop Diligence & Discipline in Planning/Preparing

1. Work honestly and faithfully (hard!)
2. Plan wisely (budget – lay it out)
3. Give first
4. Spend on basic and important necessities (Rom 12:17, (and not everything is that necessary!) integrity
5. Save for the unexpected, for the future, for opportunities (slow times, For changes, emergencies  
*Emergency Fund /Surplus – don't spend every dime every time!*  
*Investments (when you can't work as much, to prepare "with if the Lord wills" we will do this or that.*

### 3. Dig out of debt – Freedom!
