# The Whole Armor of God

## Relationship

- Genuine
- Grounded
- Growing

## Responsibility

- Put on – personally have
- Take unto – seize

## Readiness – stand having...

- Belt of truth – believing God’s truth and practicing integrity and honesty. Be truthful, place high premium on truth
- Breastplate of righteousness – as a Christian you have the imputed righteousness of God in Christ; now we need to live accordingly, developing a life of Christian character and spiritual disciplines (but avoiding self-righteousness or legalistic living)
- Shoes prepared with the gospel of peace (Rom 10:15, 8:1-10)
- Shield of faith – *complete confidence in God, believing Him, “trusting as the moments fly, trusting as the years go by”*
- Helmet of salvation – (I Thess 5:8) protection of our mind. Guarding our thinking
- Sword of the Spirit – which is the Word of God (*designed to be used accurately and properly*)
- Consistent Praying
